## **AFSIS Annual Report 2021-2022 and Future Work Plan**

### **1. Preface and Background**

Food security has been one of crucial issues of all mankind as there are millions of people around the globe that still struggling with hunger. The keys to tackle these challenges have been launched through regional and international cooperation. The United Nations members adopted the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development which expected to guide the actions of international community over the next 15 years in order to overcome challenges that the world is facing.

In regional context, AFSIS has been one of various mechanisms handling food security network system to ensure the long term and sustainable food security in the region by providing food security information and analysis for policy makers to have a constant access to reliable information.

#### **1.1 Vision**

The vision of the AFSIS is to become the centre for the ASEAN Plus Three food security information.

#### **1.2 Goals**

The goals of the AFSIS are to ensure and strengthen the ASEAN Plus Three long-term food security.

#### **1.3 AFSIS Component**

The main activities of AFSIS are divided in three functions consisting of Administrative Functions, Human Resources Development, and Food Security Information Development.



## **2. 2020-2021 Activities**

### **2.1. Administrative Function and General Management**

#### **2.1.1 The 28th Session of the Asia and Pacific Commission on Agricultural Statistics (APCAS28)**

The meeting was held on 10-14 February 2020 in Bali, Indonesia as it was hosted by the Indonesian Government and convened by the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO). The session was attended by 100 participants including 53 delegates from 24 APCAS member countries and observers from 6 countries and 9 organizations. The prominent themes on APCAS28 were Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) Indicators, the SDG Global Monitoring and Evaluation Framework, developing an Integrated System of Agricultural Statistics, the use of technology and importance of partnerships in agriculture statistics, and subsector statistics related to fisheries and livestock.

#### **2.1.2 The 29th Session of the Asia and Pacific Commission on Agricultural Statistics (APCAS29)**

The meeting was held on 22-25 November 2021 via an online platform. This virtual meeting was honorably hosted by the National Statistics Office of Mongolia and convened by the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO). APCAS aims to bring together senior statistics Officials from FAO member countries of the Asia and Pacific region, who are responsible for the development of agricultural statistics in their respective countries. They had reviewed the developments in their agricultural statistical systems since the last session and exchanged ideas with experts from FAO and other organizations on the state of food and agricultural statistics in the continent.

### **2.1.3 The 18<sup>th</sup> AFSIS Focal Point Meeting**

The 18<sup>th</sup> AFSIS Focal Point Meeting was organized by AFSIS Secretariat and hosted by Negara Brunei Darussalam on 9 June 2020 as the 1st time of the Focal Point Online Meeting and the first time for alphabetical hosting approach. The main objectives of conducting the annual Focal Point Meeting are to inform the ASEAN Plus Three Countries of the overall outcomes and achievements of AFSIS in 2019-2020 Q2, future work plan, and other related issues. Furthermore, the representative from the APTERR Secretariat presented the APTERR implementation in 2019-2020 and analytic works related to the AFSIS. The representative from the Remote Sensing Technology Center of Japan (RESTEC) updated the Meeting on AFSIS-related activities supported by the Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA) and the RESTEC in 2019-2020. The representative from the MAFF of Japan informed the Meeting about a future cooperation between the AFSIS and MAFF in order to improve agricultural statistics, and presented the actual work plan for the implementation in 2020-2022. The representative from the Korea Agency of Education, Promotion and Information Service in Food, Agricultural, Forestry and Fisheries (EPIS) presented the future collaboration between the AFSIS and the Republic of Korea with the aim of improving agricultural statistics in the ASEAN member states. The representative from People's Republic of China informed the Meeting about the cooperation of People's Republic of China projects through the AFSIS in 2019 and the further collaboration in 2020. In addition, the AFSIS technical adviser informed the Meeting of the Rice Growing Outlook (RGO) report activity. The list of delegates appears in ANNEX 1.

#### **2.1.4 The 19<sup>th</sup> AFSIS Focal Point Meeting**

The 19<sup>th</sup> AFSIS Focal Point Meeting was virtually held on 22-23 June 2021 via Zoom platform due to the situation of COVID-19. It was organized by the AFSIS Secretariat and hosted by Cambodia. The Meeting was presented with the update on AFSIS implementation in 2020-2021: Q2, the update of projects which collaborate with AFSIS, as well as the future work plan in 2021 for AFSIS Project. The representative from the APTERR Secretariat presented the APTERR implementation in 2020-2021 and analytic works related to the AFSIS. The representative from the RESTEC updated on AFSIS-related activities supported by the RESTEC in 2020-2021. The Japanese Expert of the AFSIS Secretariat informed the Meeting on an overview of the Supporting Agricultural Survey on Promoting Sustainable Agriculture (SAS-PSA) project, and the work plan of the 2nd and 3rd year project activities under the SAS-PSA project. The representative from the EPIS presented a collaboration between the AFSIS and the Republic of Korea with the aim of improving agricultural statistics and capacity building in the ASEAN Member States. The representative from People's Republic of China informed the Meeting about the cooperation of People's Republic of China projects through the AFSIS in 2020 and the further collaboration in 2021. The highlight of the meeting was the introduction to the new Japan funded

AFSIS project for 2022-2024 namely “Strengthening AFSIS Function for Emergency (SAFE) Project”. Furthermore, there was also an open session for the ASEAN Plus Three members to discuss and share their opinions regarding of the Future of AFSIS project after 2024. The Meeting was informed that the member countries required time for consideration and consultation with their higher levels on the future of AFSIS. The Meeting also recommended to prepare a meeting for a further discussion on the future of AFSIS organized by the AFSIS Secretariat around the end of 2021. AFSIS Secretariat also stated the strong will to develop the better of AFSIS Report and works. Also, AFSIS Secretariat had presented the newest project namely 'Report and Disseminate the Information Regarding the Serious Disaster' which will monitor the impact of serious disaster on food security of ASEAN or ASEAN+3 members.

### **2.1.8 The 41<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the ASEAN Food Security Reserve Board (AFSRB)**

The meeting was held on 16 June 2021 as a Video Conference. It was hosted by Negara Brunei Darussalam. AFSIS Secretariat had presented AFSIS main activities, cooperative activities during 2020-2021: Q2 focusing on Administrative Function Activities, Human Resource Development Activities, and Food Security Information Development, and the future work plan for 2021. Moreover, AFSIS Secretariat presented on activities of the SAS – PSA project in collaboration with the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF) of Japan to develop appropriate survey method for collecting data related to Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) indicator 2.4.1. which was currently in the stage of conduction pilot survey in Thailand and preparing enumerators training in Lao PDR.

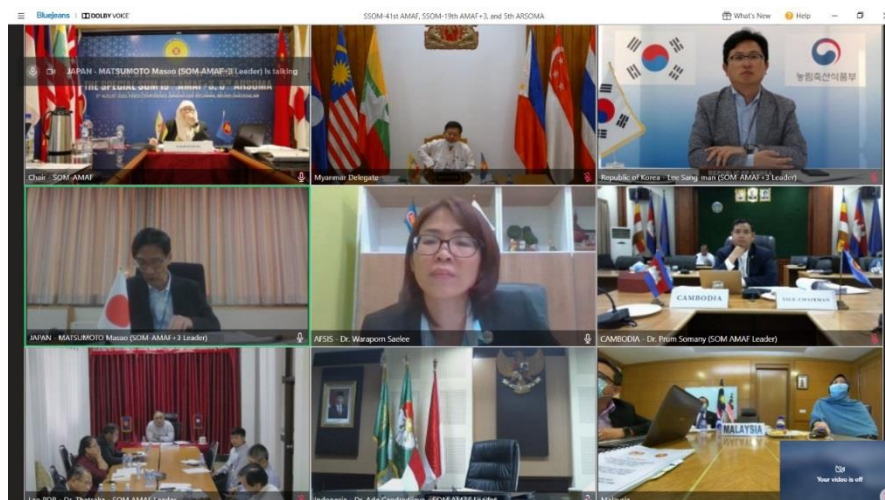

### **2.1.9 The Special Senior Officials Meeting of the 19th Meeting of the ASEAN Ministers on Agriculture and Forestry Plus Three (SSOM-19th AMAF+3)**

AFSIS Secretariat attended the Special Senior Officials Meeting of the 19th Meeting of the ASEAN Ministers on Agriculture and Forestry Plus Three (SSOM-19th AMAF+3) which was held on 5 August 2020 as a Video Conference and hosted by Negara Brunei Darussalam. The Meeting noted the progress report on the implementation of AFSIS from 2019-2020, which includes activities on human resources and food security information development. The AFSIS had published the following database & reports: Early Warning Information (EWI 22/ March 2020; EWI 23/ September 2019, EWI 24/March 2020), and the Rice Growing Outlook (RGO) – Update Rice Situation in 7 ASEAN Member States.

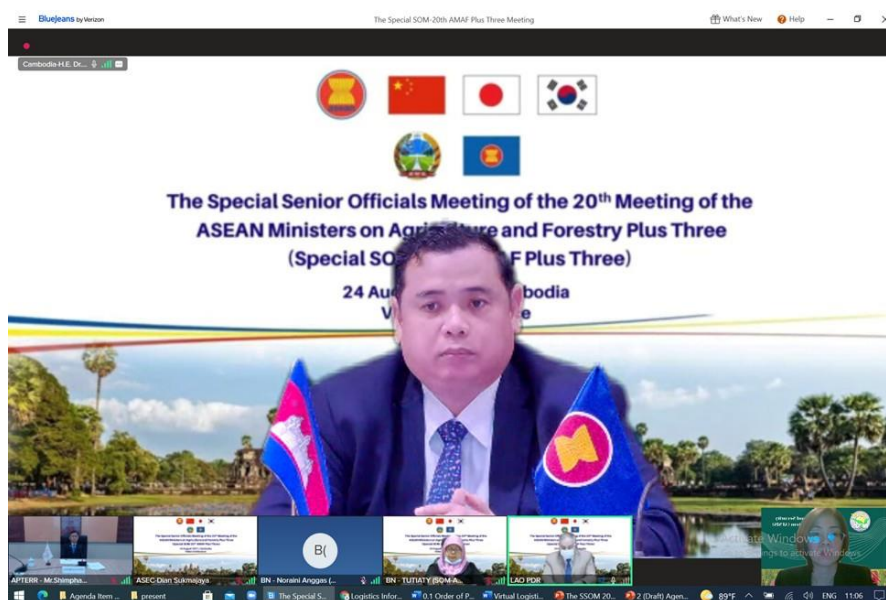

### **2.1.10 The Special Senior Officials Meeting of the 20th Meeting of the ASEAN Ministers on Agriculture and Forestry Plus Three (SSOM-20th AMAF+3)**

This Special Senior Officials Meeting of the 20th Meeting of the ASEAN Ministers on Agriculture and Forestry Plus Three (SSOM-20th AMAF+3) was conducted on 24 August 2021 virtually as a Video Conference and honorably hosted by the Kingdom of Cambodia. The Meeting acknowledged the outcomes of AFSIS implementation on 2020-2021:Q2, and reports on 5 main agricultural commodities in ASEAN. Moreover, the future plan to conduct the special meeting on “Discussion of Future of AFSIS” was stated to the meeting. Also, the progress of the Project for Supporting Agricultural Survey on Promoting Sustainable Agriculture (SAS-PSA), as well as the future work plan for 2022 were reported to the meeting. The Meeting extended the sincere gratitude to the contribution of the Office of Agricultural Economics (OAE), Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives, Thailand for leading AFSIS Secretariat.

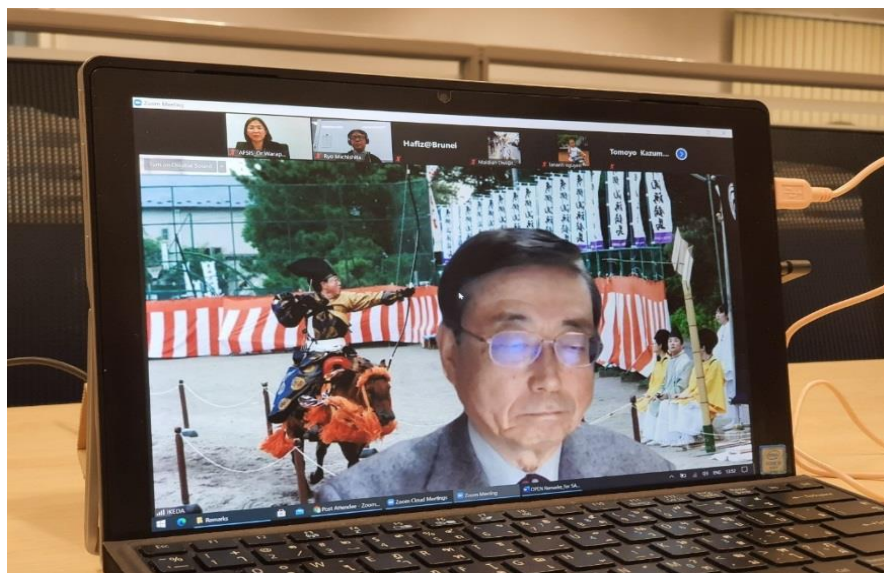
## **2.2. Human Resources Development**

For effective and successful operation of AFSIS, human resources on food security information of ASEAN Plus Three countries inevitably need to be enhanced in line with data and information.

### **2.2.1 SAKURA Exchange Program in Science (Sakura Science Plan)**

The program was organized by Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST), and RESTEC on 28 January 2021 and 4 February 2021 as a Video Conference. The objective was to develop human resources about the remote sensing principle and agricultural remote sensing application. There were 15 participants from ASEAN Countries Members with the outcome of learning about Geographic Information

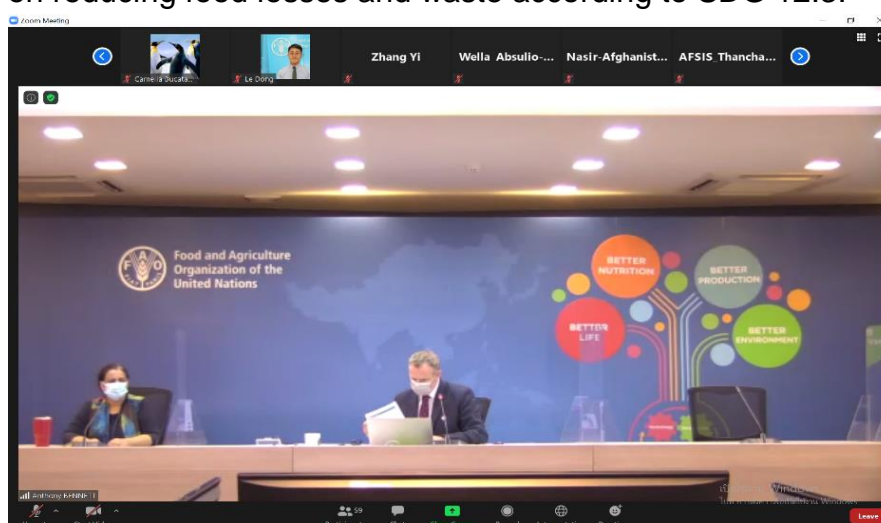
Technology and its application and utilization for agricultural sector. The first stage was an introduction of the program through the online training on January 28, 2021 and February 4, 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and the second stage was planned to be an actual Japan-visit in the second half of 2021. However, the Japan-visit was cancelled due to the COVID-19 situation. The trainees were given with an opportunity to train in the 2nd Training Program under the ASEAN-Japan Project (JAIF Project) instead.

## **2.2.2 Multi-stakeholder Virtual Consultation on the FAO Regional Strategy on Food Loss and Waste Reduction in Asia and the Pacific.**

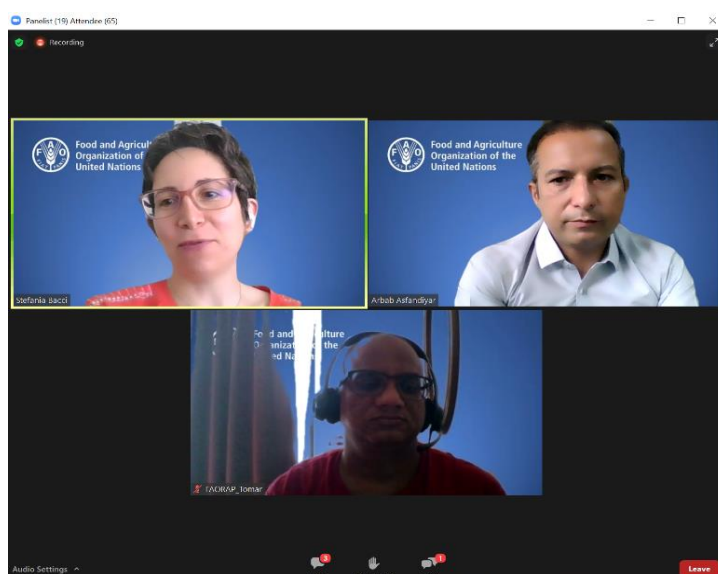
The meeting was held on 2-3 June 2021 as a Video Conference. There were 13 participants from AFSIS registration with the total 92 participants. The meeting discussed the overview of food losses and waste (FLW), Asia-Pacific FLW Strategy on this matter, and climate change and the environment. The meeting also discussed the vision, goal, and objective toward this matter, as well as opened the discussion on the roadmap on reducing food losses and waste according to SDG 12.3.

### 2.2.3 Virtual Trainings on SDG Indicator 2.4.1

From 28 June-1 July 2021, AFSIS Secretariat had participated in the Virtual Trainings on SDG indicator 2.4.1 “Proportion of Agricultural Area under Productive and Sustainable Agriculture” conducted by the Headquarter of Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) as a Video Training. There were representatives from the different 25 countries, 5 representatives from AFSIS Secretariat, and 3 AMS namely Cambodia, Lao PDR, and Thailand which also participated the training. The objectives of the training are to provide detailed training on 2.4.1 methodology, to introduce the data collection tools and instruments developed for collecting and reporting data, and to help understand and evaluate the data related to SDGs 2.4.1. The meeting also discussed concrete plans to collect data on the indicator in the short, medium, and long term.



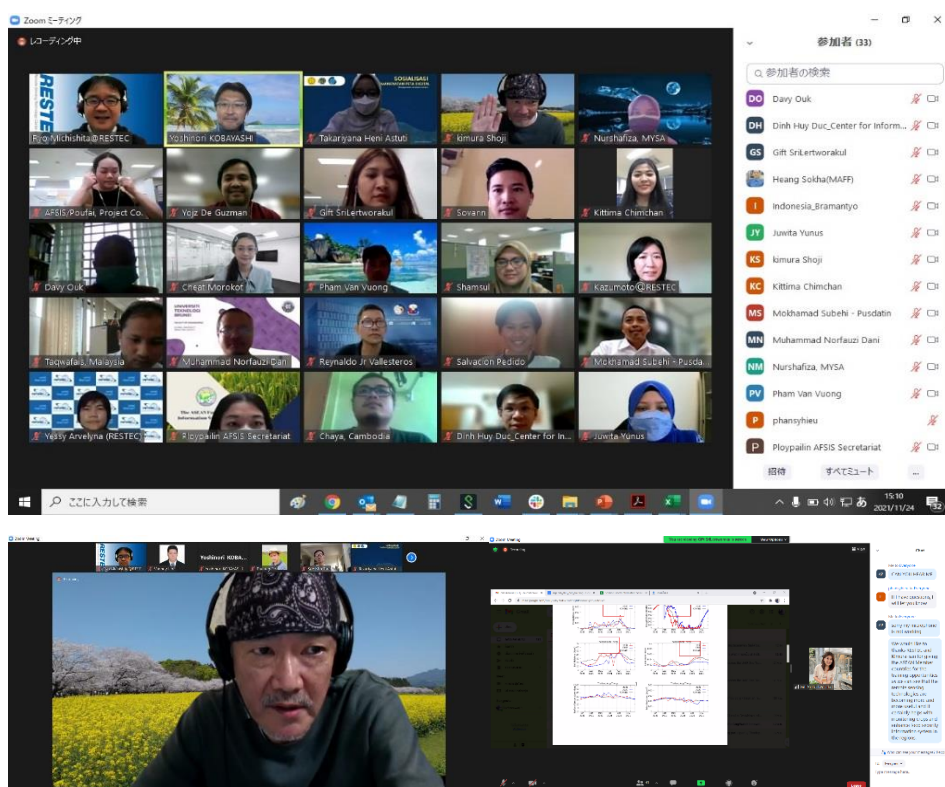

### 2.2.4 The 2nd Training Program under the ASEAN-Japan Project (JAIF Project)

The Japan Space Forum (JSF) had conducted the 2nd Training Program under the ASEAN-Japan Project (JAIF Project): Science Based Information Sharing Derived from Earth Observation Satellites for Agriculture Management in the ASEAN Region on 24 November 2021 as an online training. Prior to the online training, JSF also held the prior online self-study and report writing from 15 November to 19 November 2021 in collaboration with Sakura Science Exchange Program in practical operation. There were total 8 trainees from 8 ASEAN member countries namely Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand, and Vietnam along with 20 observers. Moreover, 9 participants from Sakura Science Project 2020 had participated as the actual Japan-visit session of 2021 was canceled due to COVID-19 situation. During the training, there was a lecture from Dr. Ryo Michishita, RESTEC, regarding the Remote Sensing of Agriculture. Also, the useful



feedbacks and comments on Crop Growing Assessment Report Writing from Mr. Shoji Kimura, AFSIS Technical Advisor, were given to the trainees. Lastly, an active discussion forum was opened for the participants to share their opinions or questions.

## 2.2.5 The Final Workshop under the ASEAN-Japan Project (JAIF Project)

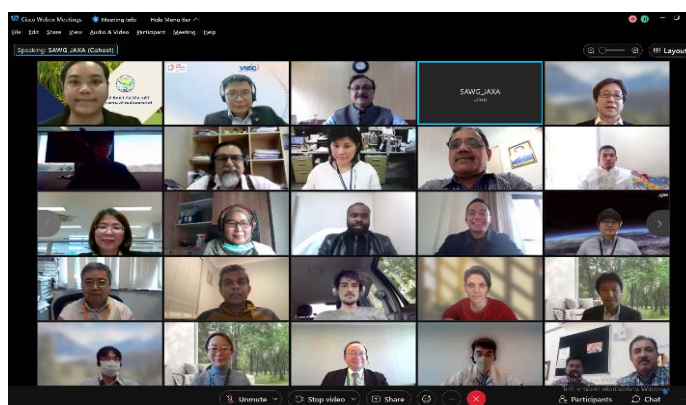
This meeting was held on 26 November 2021 as a Video Conference which was conducted by the Japan Space Forum (JSF). The objectives of this Final Workshop were to report achievement of this project and share knowledge obtained through the training programs, to report achievement and outcome from this capacity building project, to report the latest application activities by using satellite data from proponents (LAPAN and ICALRD/MOA) and technical partner (JAXA), and to raise awareness among main stakeholders about the project, practical usage of space based agromet information and identify areas of possible engagement with other stakeholders. The Meeting acknowledged the presentation given by Dr. Waraporn Saelee, AFSIS Manager, under the topic “Toward practical usage of space based agromet information”.

## 2.2.6 The 27th Session of the Asia-Pacific Regional Space Agency Forum (APRSAF-27)

This virtual conference was conducted on 30 November 2021 which was co-organized by Vietnam Academy of Science and Technology (VAST) with Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) of Japan, and Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA). During Satellite Applications for Societal Benefit Working Group (SAWG), AFSIS Secretariat delivered the presentation regarding AFSIS Rice Growing Outlook (RGO) activities and collaboration related to remote sensing technologies with RESTEC, JAXA, and ISRO. Also, Dr. Waraporn Saelee had stated to the Working Group of the importance and possibility to use the satellite data together with the survey data by the AMS to create more accurate and precise data for the AFSIS Early Warning Information Report in the future. This SAWG session was to contribute to common regional issues in the Asia-Pacific Region using space technology, in particular, Earth Observation Satellites and to establish and strengthen the cooperative framework between space agencies and stakeholders in a sustainable way.

### **3. Food Security Information Development**

#### **3.1 AFSIS Database Maintenance and Website: [www.aptfsis.com](http://www.aptfsis.com)**

AFSIS Secretariat keeps updating news and events, and publication on AFSIS website. There is also a Knowledge Base platform for disseminating materials from workshops or training on AFSIS website. For the Statistic Database, AFSIS secretariat has already developed “the Key-in Statistic System Platform” and sent the username, password, and manual to AFSIS Focal Points since June 2020. The statistical database consists of 5 commodities which are rice maize, cassava, sugarcane, and soybean with 11 items which are Production, Crop calendar, Farmgate price, Wholesale price, Population information, Labor force, GDP, Balance sheet, Land use, Irrigation area, Costs of production. The data of each country is available from 1983 to 2018, except the data from Japan, Lao PDR, Philippines, Singapore, and Cambodia which are available until 2020, and the data from Myanmar, Vietnam, and Thailand are available until 2021.

#### **3.2 Food Security Information Reports**

The reports that AFSIS has published on AFSIS website ([www.aptfsis.com](http://www.aptfsis.com)) are as follows.

##### **3.2.1 Early Warning Information (EWI) Report**

According to the suggestion made in the 18th AFSIS Focal Point Meeting in June 2020, AFSIS has changed the data's presentation and formation of EWI report since EWI No. 25 to be similar to an Early Warning report and presented differently from ACO report. The EWI Report No. 25 is about the crops' situation of 5 important agricultural crop commodities namely rice, maize, sugarcane, soybean, and cassava, and the effect of COVID-19 toward food security situation of 10 ASEAN member countries, except Singapore. Since, EWI Report No. 26, the trading information of import and export are included for all 10 ASEAN member countries. In this EWI Report No. 26, as Singapore is not mainly focusing on producing agricultural products, the import and export information are stated instead of the crops' situation. In addition, the CIF, FOB information, and the effect of COVID-19 toward food security situation in Singapore are also presented. For EWI Report No. 27, it remains to be the crops' situation of the same commodities from 9 ASEAN member countries namely Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand, and Vietnam. The EWI report are presented on AFSIS website regularly on March and September. For year 2020-2021, AFSIS published EWI No.24 (March 2020 issued), EWI No.25 (September 2020 issued), EWI No.26 (March 2021 issued), and EWI No.27 (September 2021 issued) respectively.

##### **3.2.2 Agricultural Commodity Outlook (ACO) Report**

Agricultural Commodity Outlook (ACO) Report is an ASEAN agricultural production situation analyses report presents both supply and demand information for 5 important agricultural crop commodities, namely rice, maize, sugarcane, soybean,



and cassava. The information cover crop production, import data, export data, price, and balance sheet. This report has been published twice a year in June and December since 2008. In 2020-2021, AFSIS released ACO No.24 (June 2020 issued), ACO No.25 (December 2020 issued), ACO No.26 (June 2021 issued), respectively. For the ACO No.27 (December 2021 issued), it will be published in January 2022.

### **3.2.3 Rice Growing Outlook (RGO) Report**

The monthly RGO report is the activity that AFSIS collaborates with RESTEC to report the situation of rice growing in 7 countries of ASEAN member states, namely Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand, and Vietnam since October 2013. Besides, AFSIS supports this information to Asia-RiCE on GEOGLAM and disseminates this information on AFSIS website monthly to support agricultural monitoring and forecasting.

### **3.2.4 Report and Disseminate the Information Regarding the Serious Disaster**

AFSIS Secretariat and ASEAN Plus Three member countries have presented the newest project called “Report and Disseminate the Information Regarding the Serious Disaster” which will monitor the serious disaster and its impact on food security of ASEAN members countries. AFSIS has published 10 reports in AFSIS website under “News&Events” banner which are:

- 1) Tropical Storm Sinlaku Effects toward Food Security in Lao PDR, Thailand, and Vietnam
- 2) Typhoon Molave Effects toward Food Security in Vietnam
- 3) Eruption of Mount Ile Lewotolok Effects toward Food Security in Indonesia
- 4) Heavy Rain Flood in Indonesia
- 5) Monsoonal Flooding in Myanmar
- 6) Southwest Monsoon in the Philippines
- 7) Tropical Cyclone Dianmu
- 8) Mount Semeru Eruption in Indonesia
- 9) Flooding and Landslide in West Nusa Tenggara, Indonesia
- 10) Typhoon Rai (Odette) in Philippines

## **4. Project for Supporting Agricultural Survey on Promoting Sustainable Agriculture (SAS-PSA)**

The Project for Supporting Agricultural Survey on Promoting Sustainable Agriculture” or “SAS-PSA is a Technical Support Project funded by Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF), Japan for 2 years and 8 months starting from 26 March 2020 to 25 November 2022. The main objectives of the SAS-PSA project are 1) to achieve the goals of SDGs indicator 2.4.1 in the region by developing data for agricultural productivity improvement and promotion of sustainable agriculture, and use as basic data for policy making, 2) to strengthen the AFSIS

activities which contribute to monitoring the food security situation throughout the ASEAN region, and 3) to provide accurate and comparable agricultural statistics data collected using a unified survey method developed by the project. MAFF, Japan supports the budget for implementing the pilot survey regarding SGD indicator 2.4.1 in 3 target countries which are Thailand in 2020, Lao PDR in 2021, and Cambodia in 2022 and dispatches one Japanese expert to work at AFSIS Secretariat office. The final report of the pilot survey in Thailand has finished in the end of August 2021. While, the final report of the pilot survey in Lao PDR will be completed in January 2022. For Cambodia, the pilot survey will be conducted during 10-17 January 2022.

## **5. Future Work-plan**

### **5.1 Develop Database and website**

- Collaborating with ASEAN Plus Three countries to keep updating Statistic Database of AFSIS Website to the current year.
- Collaborates with 10 ASEAN member countries to continue publish the ACO and EWI reports.
- Continue disseminating RGO Report.
- Continue developing the project to Report and Disseminate the Information regarding the Serious Disaster.

### **5.2 Improve the Quality of Food Security Information**

- Carry on the Project for Supporting Agricultural Survey on Promoting Sustainable Agriculture in ASEAN Region in 3 target countries (Thailand, Lao PDR, and Cambodia).
- Continue supporting Real Time ASEAN Food Security Information Network and Developing Human Resource 3<sup>rd</sup> Phase.

### **5.3 Administrative**

- Conducting the Special meeting on “Discussion on Future of AFSIS” in February 2022.
- The 20th AFSIS Focal Point Meeting in Indonesia, Jakarta, June 2022. The dates are still not fixed.
- Continue with the Plus Three Countries in providing capacity building workshops and related technical trainings
